

An Invitation

Lutheran archivists, historians, librarians, and other interested individuals and institutions are invited to become members of the Lutheran Historical Conference, an interdisciplinary organization founded in 1962. LHC brings together scholars from various Lutheran traditions, including the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod.

Purposes

The Lutheran Historical Conference fosters cooperation among persons and institutions concerned with research, documentation, and preservation of the resources revealing experiences of Lutheranism in North America, specifically:

- ◆ To encourage research and production of scholarly works dealing with the history of Lutheranism in North America.
- ◆ To provide a channel for communication and cooperation among Lutheran archivists, historians, librarians.
- ◆ To coordinate the archival, microfilm, and historical activities of the Lutheran church bodies.
- ◆ To foster the utilization of modern technologies in the accomplishment of germane tasks.
- ◆ To stimulate future efforts and to seek to avoid duplication of effort.

The Lutheran Historical Conference has the following membership categories:
